JUST is the social development organization of the Catholic Diocese of Agartala and has been involved in a variety of development initiatives in Tripura for the past 27 years. JUST works within the framework of its vision and mission, namely, self-reliance through empowerment and networking with like-minded NGOs, to help build a better society. It also works within the

framework of the Catholic Social Teaching which emphasizes that we work for those on the margins of society. The goal of JUST is not merely to render services to the poor but to ensure that the poor define and design their rights which are relevant for their dignified life, and create systems to access them. This demands a critical engagement of the people's institutions with the governance structures at different levels. JUST is committed to this task.

In this Annual Report for 2023-24 you will read about some programs and interventions that were conducted during the reporting year, mainly in the rural areas of the State of Tripura.

- Facilitating Agricultural Resilient Measures (FARM-Northeast) is being implemented in 2 villages under Hezamara R.D Block, 7 villages under Amarpur R.D Block, and 3 villages under Karbook R.D Block. The project aims at "Empowering Community for Nutritional food intake through obtaining status of Food Sovereignty by adopting Organic farming, Horticulture and Animal husbandry as sustainable livelihood options".
- Engineering Empowerment of Reang Women Group (EnERW-G). The Project is being implemented in 20 villages of Ganganagar R.D Block by covering 350 beneficiaries/stakeholders. The project aims to bring positive changes in the livelihood practices of local communities through promotion of groups.
- Learning Centers for Indigenous children for school re-enrollment, prevention of school dropout and child labour in Karbook'. JUST implemented this program by opening 10 Remedial Education Centers profiting 360 children in the neediest rural areas in Karbook Subdivision under Gomati District.
- Women Empowerment through Capacity building programs is being implemented in 24 Parishes of Agartala Diocese. The Project aims at empowering, strengthening and enhancing the capacity of women socially, spiritually and politically, and thereby promoting women's social emancipation.
- Peace Project: The project aims to build relations with different communities living in Tripura, to have mutual respect, reduce violence, confidence-building measures and build bridges of trust in each other and live in harmony. It is implemented in 20 Schools, 2 Youth Clubs and 6 SHGs Federation.
- Special Coaching and care for the children: The goal of the project is to offer special coaching and care for the children in the elementary School in order to assure adequate physical growth and knowledge in education. The Project is supported by SMILE FOUNDATION and is operational at Damdamia, Nepali Basti and Adharni Tea Garden.

In conclusion I wish to say that for any Organization to run smoothly we need the support of many hands. At JUST these persons are the Director, Coordinators, the field Staff, Office Staff and support Staff, who do their best to keep the organization moving. To each and every one of them, and to our benefactors, I say THANK YOU very much.

I am very happy to present to you the Annual Report of JUST for the year 2023– 2024. JUST is in its 27th year of service to the people of Tripura. As I look back the year 23-24, I feel happy and say strongly that JUST has not forgotten it's Mission 'empower the poor and the marginalized'.

We spent this year creating new SHGs and Farmers clubs in the interior parts of the state believing that the economic empowerment paves the way for the holistic growth. This year we created 34 SHGs and 18 Farmers Clubs. Old 20 SHGs, 8 Farmers clubs and 7 Federations are being strengthened by having their own Income Generation Activities individually and as groups. They are also being trained and supported by government departments like KVK and ICAR through our intervention.

Three of our parishes have started implementing the concept 'CARITAS PARISH' in their parishes and started saving money through Income Generation Activities. This is mainly to respond towards the economic development of the people. I take this opportunity to thank the parish priests for being part of the social activities of the diocese.

JUST is continuing its responsibility towards environment through the 'GREEN SUNDAY' concept by encouraging the people to concentrate on their behavior pattern in order to save the planet. I would like to thank all the priests and religious, members of SHGs, Clubs and students who have cooperated with us in this regard for the last 6 years.

I would like to express my gratitude to our chairman Most Rev. A Just, Self-reliant and peaceful society based on human values

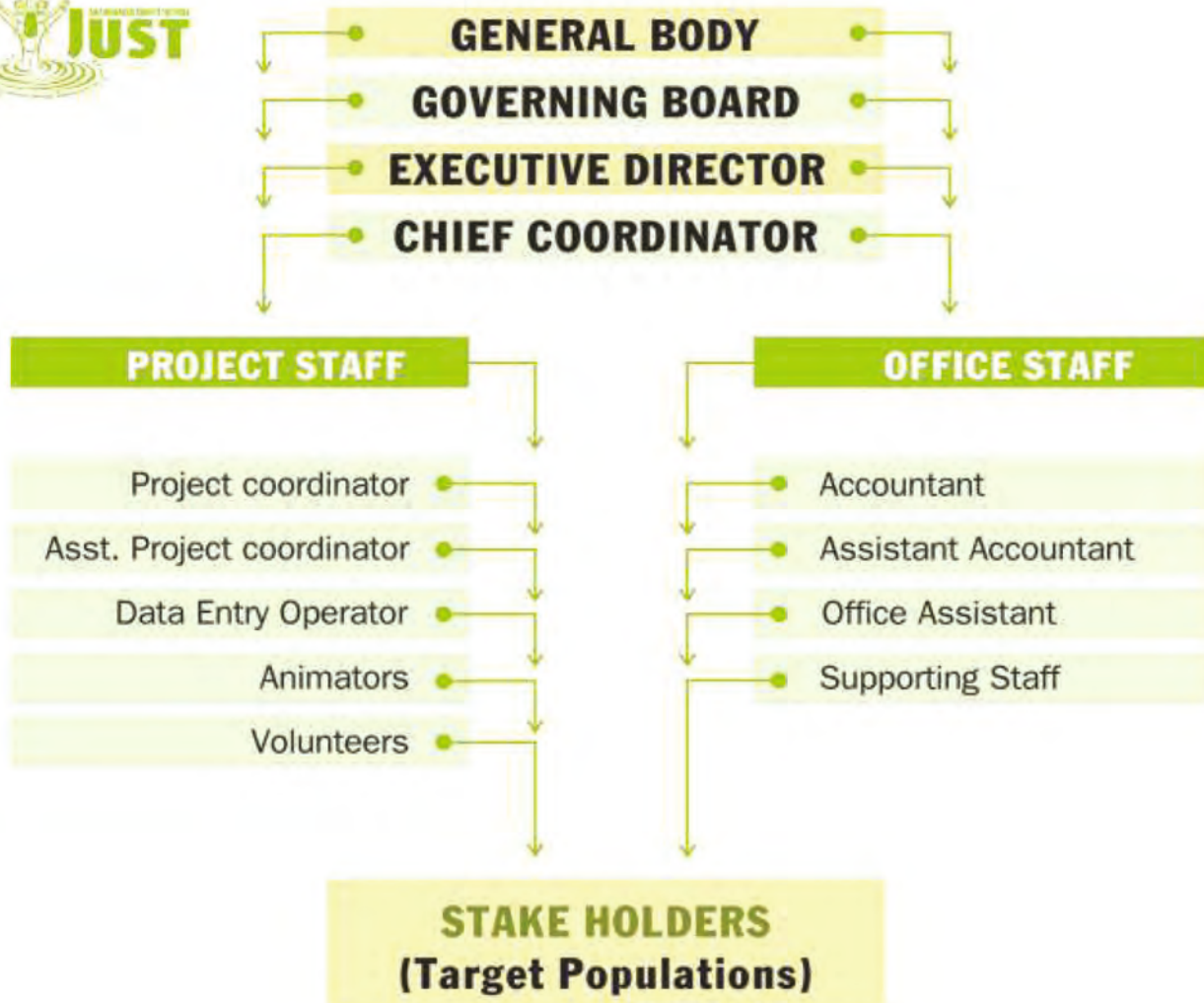
MISSION

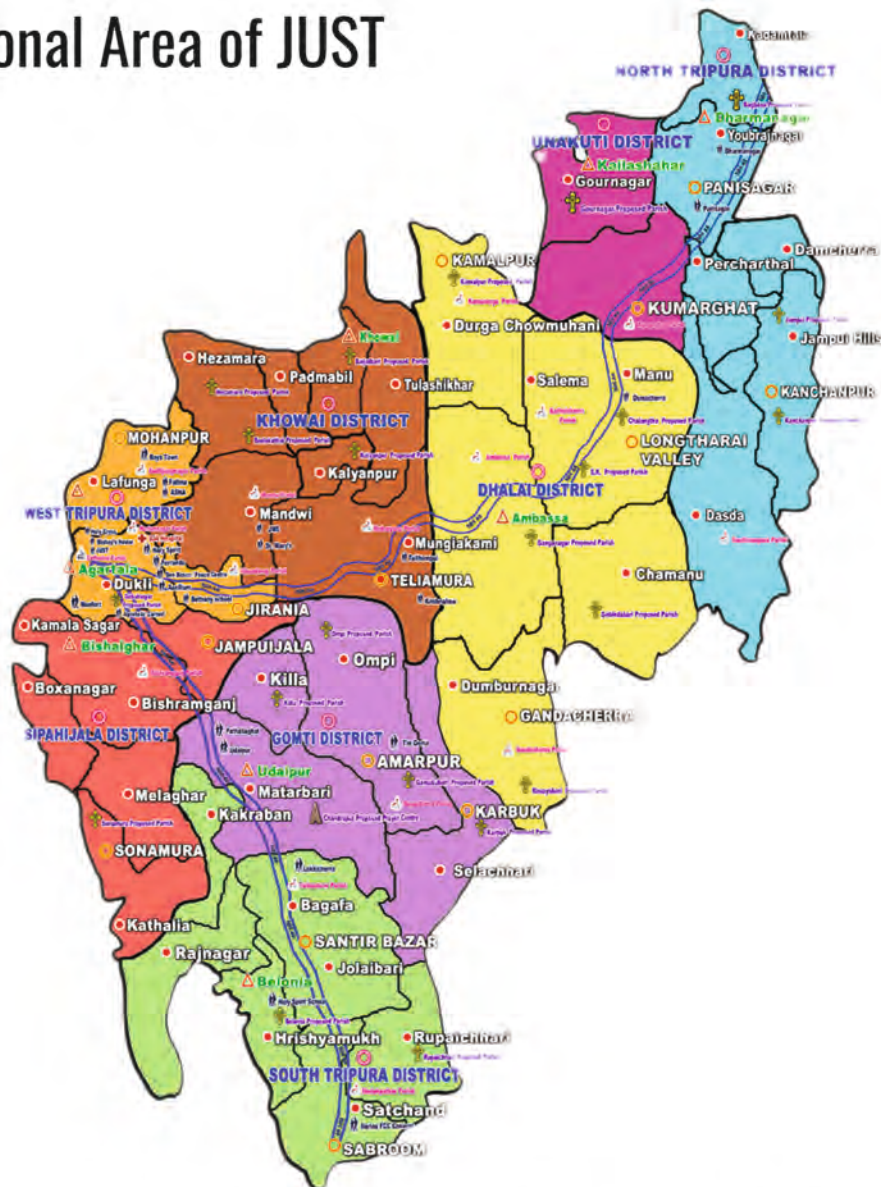

Operational Area of JUST



From a bird's eye view, Tripura is the third smallest state in India having an international frontier with Bangladesh (839 km). The geographical area of Tripura is 10,491 km with a population of 36.71 lakh (3.67 million). The capital is Agartala and the principal languages are Bengali and Kokborok.

It is a land-locked with hilly state in North-Eastern India. It is surrounded by Bangladesh in the north, west and South. It is accessible to the rest of the state only through Cachar District of Assam and Aizawl District of Mizoram in the East. The state lies between 22.09 and 24.32' N longitudes. From north to South its maximum distance is about 184kms and from East to west 113 kms. It was declared a union territory on 01/11/1959 and then later elevated to the status of a full-fledged State on 21/01/1972. Administratively the State is divided into 8 Districts. The Developmental interventions of JUST are spread in all the 8 districts of the State.

Special Coaching & care for the children by SMILE FOUNDATION



The goal of the project is to offer special coaching and care to the children under the elementary School in order to assure adequate physical growth and knowledge in the education under the Mission Education of JUST at Damdamia, Nepali Basti and Adharni Tea Garden supported by SMILE FOUNDATION

‘Learning centers for Indigenous children for school re-enrollment, prevention of school dropout and child labour in Karbook’

General Introduction of the Project:

JUST implemented a program to open 10 Remedial Education centres profiting 360 children in the neediest rural areas in Karbook subdivision under Gomati District, Tripura. Mostly inherited by the tribes such as Tripura, Reang, Uchoi and Mog. The people in the areas are mostly farmers and daily wage laborers and they could hardly afford for their children’s education.

The implementation of this programme brought a good impact on the people and their way of assuming about quality education and its importance in their lives and even setting a good example to the other neighboring villages. The children are provided with learning materials such as notebooks, pen, pencil, eraser and games items. The children are also served nutritional food such as Egg, Biscuits, Bread, Cake, banana thrice a week in all the centres. It is to keep the children away from the malnourishment and keep them active in their studies.

Achievements:

□ Parents-Teachers Association have been formed in all the centers to bring a mutual trust and understanding between them

□ Distribution of Sports items such as, football, skipping rope and chess to the children to increase their competitive spirit, concentration and more active in their studies.

□ The children had set up an example to promote clean and plastic free environment for the villagers by planting trees and doing cleanliness drive programs in the village.

□ The children have become aware of health care and hygiene. They practice daily both at home and outside the home such as washing hand before and after eating, washing their body with soap, eat healthy and clean food, keep their nails clean, throwing the biscuits wrap in the dustbin.



□ Children parliament program is conducted in the centres regularly. Such as program on child rights, street play on drug addiction and pollution free environment.

AGRO FARM

Agro Farm at Damdamia managed by JUST has set an example by producing vegetables and fruits through organic farming process. This farm is basically set up to train and encourage people to produce crops through organic process. Many SHGs have been trained and they have adopted organic farming process in their Agro practices. Integrated farming is practiced with a mini-cattle farm, fishery, livestock rearing, organic vegetable and varieties of Bamboos, Poultry and Orchards.

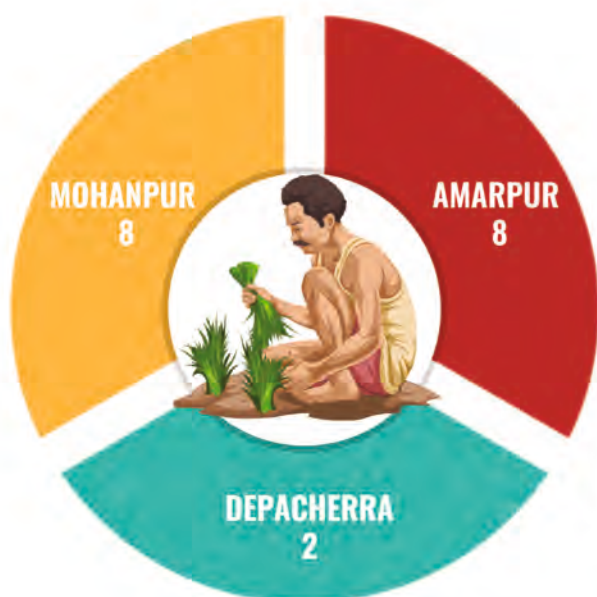

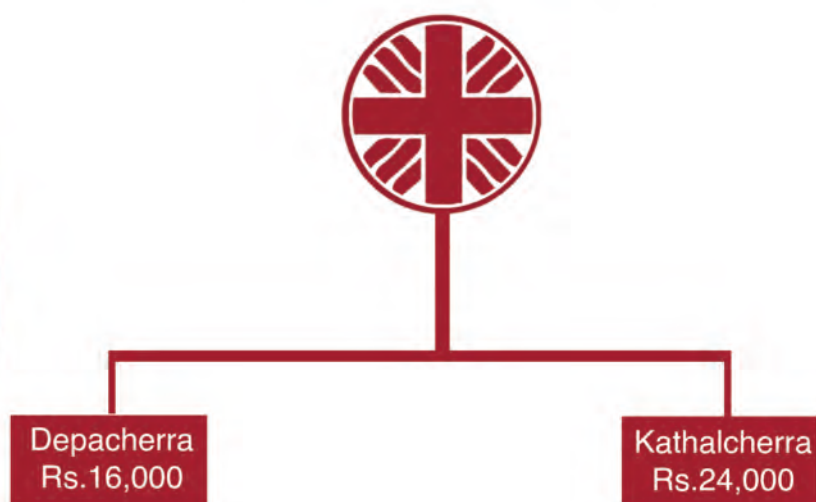

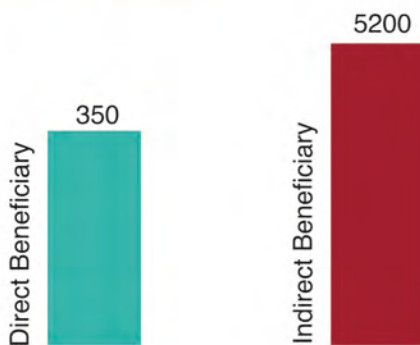
Engineering Empowerment of Reang Women Group (EnERW-G)

General Introduction:

The Project is being implemented in 20 villages of Ganganagar R.D Block by covering 350 beneficiaries/stakeholders. The project aims to bring positive changes in the livelihood practices of local communities through promotion of groups. The behavioral and attitudinal changes brought in by the project among the women will empower them to actively participate in decision making process at the community level. The socio-cultural changes brought in by the project, in terms of livelihood practices, will have lasting impact on the target beneficiaries even beyond the project period. The project will significantly affect the lives of Reang tribal SHG members in their income generation activities, livelihood security and self employability. It will strengthen the target communities' income generation opportunities through tools and capacity building support. It is expected that the beneficiaries will continue the livelihood practices, which directly contribute to increased family economy.

Achievements



20 new Self Help Groups (SHGs) have been formed and 20 existing groups are strengthened.

2 new Clusters comprising of 10 old groups in each cluster have been formed.



15,000 arecanut and 500 Litchi saplings distributed to the SHG members with 90% survival rate.

SHGs are formally recognized by the Government and therefore all the SHGs to have opened a bank account.



After organizing several awareness programs by JUST, SHGs started availing government grants for construction of their dwelling houses. Since April 2023 to March 2024, 146 SHG

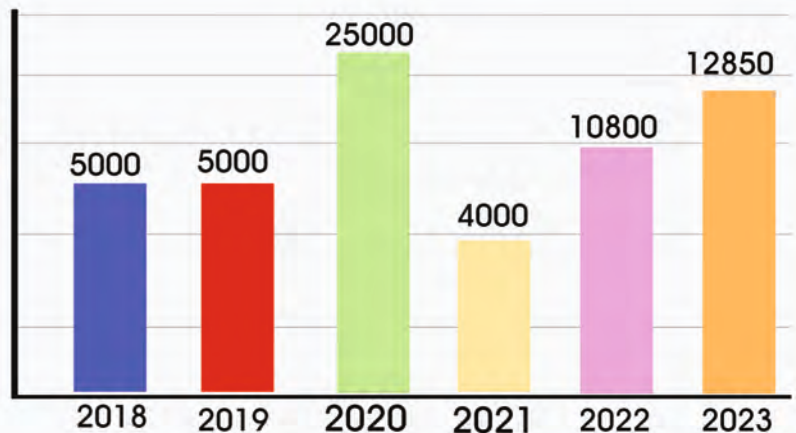

FARM NE-IV

General Introduction:

Facilitating Agricultural Resilient Measures is being implemented in 2 villages under Hezamara R.D Block, West Tripura, 7 villages under Amarpur R.D Block and 3 villages under Karbook R.D Block, Gomati District. The project aims at “Empowering Community for Nutritional food intake through obtaining status of Food Sovereignty by adopting Organic farming, Horticulture and Animal husbandry as sustainable livelihood options”.

Beneficiaries:

Direct Beneficiaries: 300

Indirect Beneficiaries: 4,744





Achievements:

1. 52 SHG members have adopted Oyster Mushroom cultivation for their consumption and are selling in the market as well.
2. 19 piglets have been distributed to 19 farmers, 2 died due to sickness.
3. 11,250 Fingerlings were distributed to 25 farmers after 1 day training at ICAR.
4. 400 Apple berry saplings were distributed to 1 farmer's club with a 96% survival rate.
5. 32 families are utilizing 80% of their cultivable land and have increased their production.
6. 3 Farmer's clubs are regularly doing collective cultivation seasonally and have earned approximately Rs. 1 to 1.5 lakhs for each group.
7. 26 farmers from 6 villages are selling their agro-products in the local markets regularly.
8. The Areca leaves Plate Machine was installed at Uruabari on 28th January 2024. so far, they have earned about Rs. 26,000/-
9. 92 families are involved in millet farming either for their consumption or for selling.

PEACE PROJECT

General introduction

The project aims to build relations with different communities living in Tripura, to have mutual respect, reduce violence, confidence-building measures and build bridges of trust in each other and live in harmony. The project empowers and strengthens to encourage reconciliation among the target groups for promoting peace in educational institutions, civil society and inter-religious organizations for violence reduction, mutual exchanges and learning to lead to peace and harmony in Tripura. It is implemented in 20 Schools, 2 youth clubs and 6 SHGs Federation.

Achievements:

- Regular awareness programs on substance abuse are being conducted by the school peace club animators in the School.
- The school peace clubs animators are taking initiative in conducting the peace activities and they are playing a role in the school with children in bring peace within the school campus.
- The peace club members have acquired the knowledge on conflict management skills and understood more on peace and conflict.
- The peace club members are taking peace initiative with their friends with different communities and they are showing more interested in peace education.
- The women peace club members have improved their confidence and are actively spearheading efforts to diminish violence in their villages, while also taking proactive measures to curb youth involvement in substance abuse.



WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROJECT THROUGH CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMS

General Introduction:

Women Empowerment through Capacity building programs is a project of JUST being implemented in 24 Parishes of Agartala Diocese. The Project aims at empowering, Strengthening and enhancing the capacity of women socially, spiritually and politically and thereby promoting women's social emancipation. The project has begun from the month of January 2024 and various training programs have been conducted in different parishes or deaneries as per the plan. The Project has been implemented in eight districts of Tripura.

Achievements:

- Mothers have understood the need to instill the values of life and unity among their children and other family members specially building relationship.
- Women/mothers have become aware of their duties and responsibilities in upholding the principles, morals and ethics in family life and they are empowered to educate their children.
- Women/mothers have become sensitive to the need to fight against all social, financial and spiritual evils that are threat to their faith and their family.

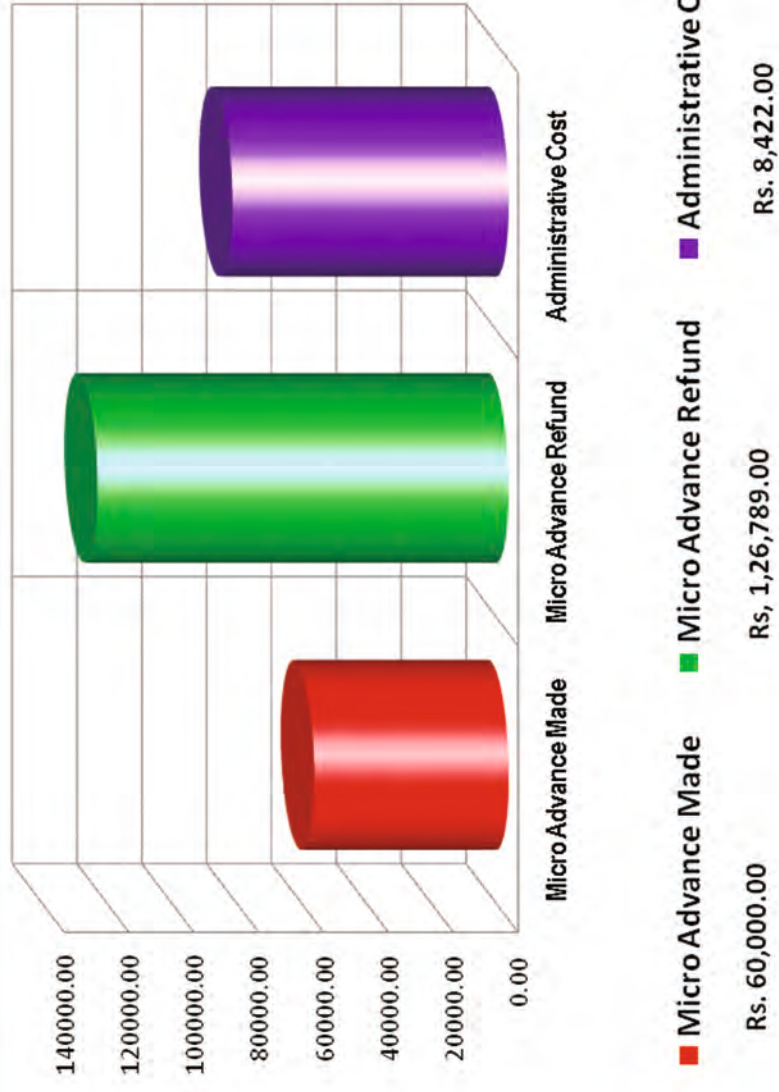
